- » Observe and interact with teachers & students in the classrooms.
- » Clear property for future construction, gardens, and playground.
- » Renovation of original homestead for future missionary bunkhouse.
- » Construct latrine & showers for bunkhouse.
- » Share Christ's love while working side by side with community on above projects.
- » Evangelizing with the community through evening worship & study and visiting homes.

the trip

- » Hotel accommodations with nice ocean views, can sleep 2–4.
- » We will take shoes, clothing, school supplies, & food supplies.
- » Food is local, may want to bring your own food if you are particular.
- » Electricity is subject to outages, so battery or wind up alarm clock suggested or obtain international cell phone service.
- » Be prepared for a 2–3 hour drive from the airport.
- » Climate is very similar to Florida, can get hot & humid.
- » Will traverse river in vehicle to get to Lavanneau, not a problem unless it rains too much.
- » Informational meetings will occur late February & March.
