the trip

- » There is a lot of walking, including stairs.
- » Sleeping accommodations are in a non-air-conditioned building with limited water access.
- » Construction is the key focus of the work on this trip. There will be lifting, loading, flights of stairs, cement mixing.
- » We will worship with our local church on Sunday morning and evening. Appropriate dress is required.
- » We trust that God will bring together a team where a variety of skills can be utilized. Ideal roles (but not a must): fluent in Spanish, lead music, handle the team finances, lead devotions, be the trip journalist, or be the trip photographer.
