the work

- » Build relationships with our supported church plant and local population.
- » Teach VBS curriculum to local Mexican families- including lessons, music, crafts and activities.
- » This VBS will take place in a local park.
- » Preparation of crafts will comprise most of our days.

the trip

- » There is walking, including stairs.
- » Sleeping accommodations will be in a local hotel with both air-conditioning and beds.
- » Children are welcome! Language has little impact on communication between children and we are all blessed to see God's love shared with all ages.
- » We purchase supplies for, and prepare crafts for 300+ Mexican brothers and sisters.
- » We will have one afternoon free to enjoy the local beaches and/ or sightsee.
- » We will worship with our local church on Sunday morning and evening. Appropriate dress is required.
- » Participation in daily devotions is an expectation (all ages!).
- » We will eat some local food, but will have food available at the hotel for snacks and breakfasts (Mexican bread-yum!, cheeses, peanut butter, granola bars, etc.) Local water is of some concern, but we buy large quantities for drinking, brushing teeth, etc.
- » We trust that God will bring together a team where a variety of skills can be utilized. Ideal roles (but not a must): fluent in Spanish, lead music, handle the team finances, lead devotions, be the trip journalist, or be the trip photographer.



* Please note for all trips: Payment for airfare (non-refundable) is due 30 days prior to departure (or when tickets are ordered).
