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the work

- » Build relationships with the local missionaries and immigrants.
- » The field missionaries are flexible with the work we do while there. It largely depends on the skills we bring to them.
- » In the past, we have taught English and Spanish, led devotions, games and crafts, and built shelving in the church.
- » Going to the market to pray while the missionaries invite women to the next session of classes has been an ongoing activity. Prayer walks are also possible.

the trip

- » There is a lot of walking, including stairs.
- » Sleeping accommodations in the past have been in an apartment or seminary.
- » We take gifts to the missionaries (peanut butter is a favorite).
- » We purchase supplies for the crafts.
- » We will have time for sightseeing.
- » We encourage everyone to have a personal testimony ready.
- » We trust that God will bring together a team of men and women who have a variety of skills that can be utilized. Ideal roles (but not a must): fluent in Spanish, lead music, handle the team finances, lead devotions, be the trip journalist, or be the trip photographer.
