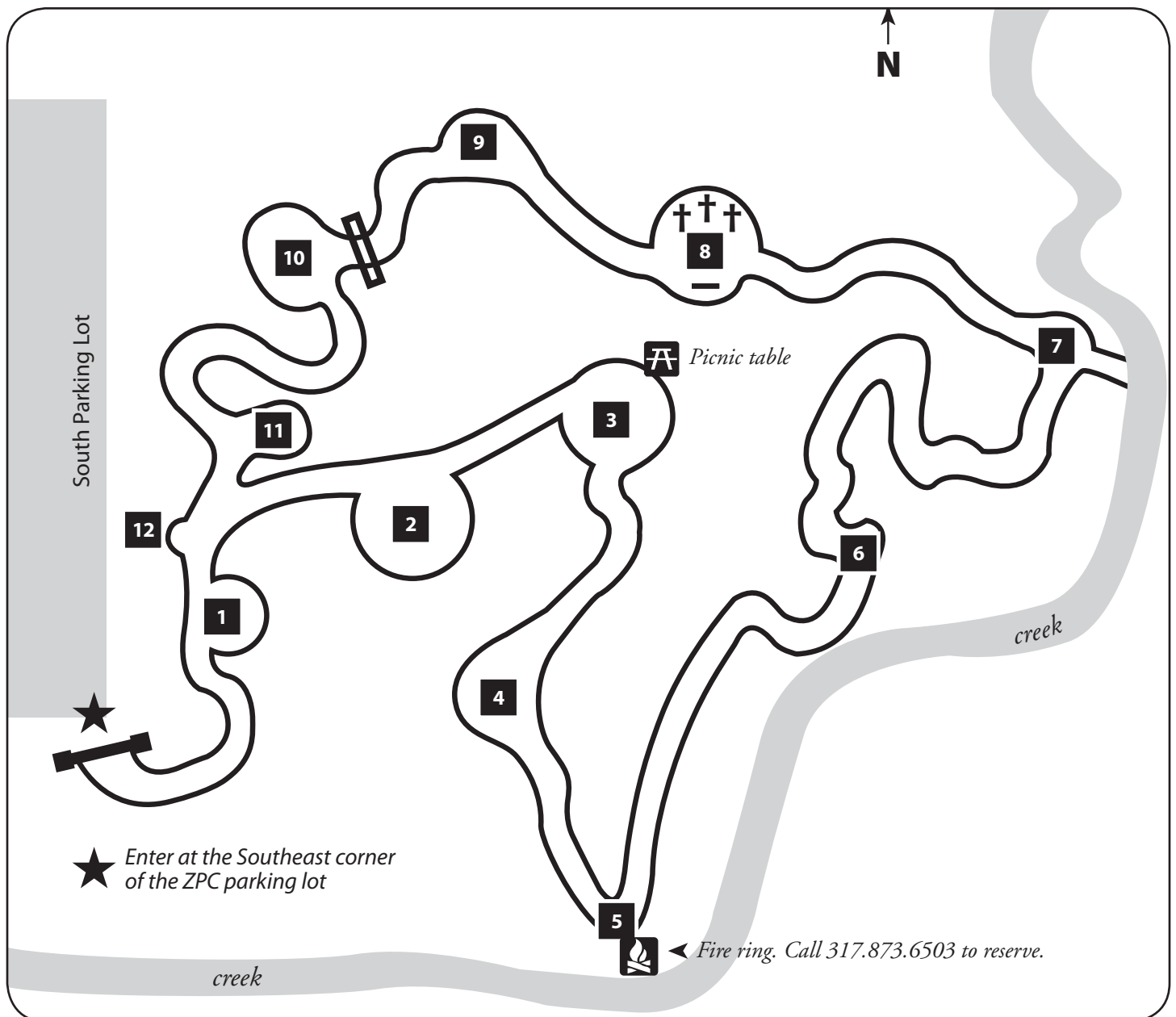


ZPC Prayer Path

Prayer Path Verses

Station 1: Be Still

"Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth." Psalm 46:10

Station 2: Circle of Praise

"I will praise you, O LORD, with all my heart; I will tell of all your wonders." Psalm 9:1

Station 3: Banquet Table

"And when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, 'This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me.' In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, 'This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me.'" 1 Corinthians 11:24–25

Station 4: Gethsemane

"Watch and pray so that you will not fall into temptation. The spirit is willing, but the body is weak." Matthew 26:41

Station 5: Spirit of Fire

"The fire on the altar must be kept burning; it must not go out. Every morning the priest is to add firewood and arrange the burnt offering on the fire and burn the fat of the fellowship offerings on it." Leviticus 6:12

Station 6: Crown of Thorns

"But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon him, and by his wounds we are healed." Isaiah 53:5

Station 7: Living Waters

"Jesus answered her, 'If you knew the gift of God and who it is that asks you for a drink, you would have asked him and he would have given you living water.'" John 4:10

Station 8: Calvary

"And anyone who does not carry his cross and follow me cannot be my disciple." Luke 14:27

Station 9: King of the Jews

"Meanwhile Jesus stood before the governor, and the governor asked him, 'Are you the king of the Jews?' 'Yes, it is as you say,' Jesus replied." Matthew 27:11

Station 10: The Gate | John 10:9

"I am the gate; whoever enters through me will be saved. He will come in and go out, and find pasture."

Station 11: Cathedral Windows

"Now when Daniel learned that the decree had been published, he went home to his upstairs room where the windows opened toward Jerusalem. Three times a day he got down on his knees and prayed, giving thanks to his God, just as he had done before." Daniel 6:10

Station 12: Lamp Stand

"In the same way, let your light shine before men, that they may see your good deeds and praise your Father in heaven." Matthew 5:16
