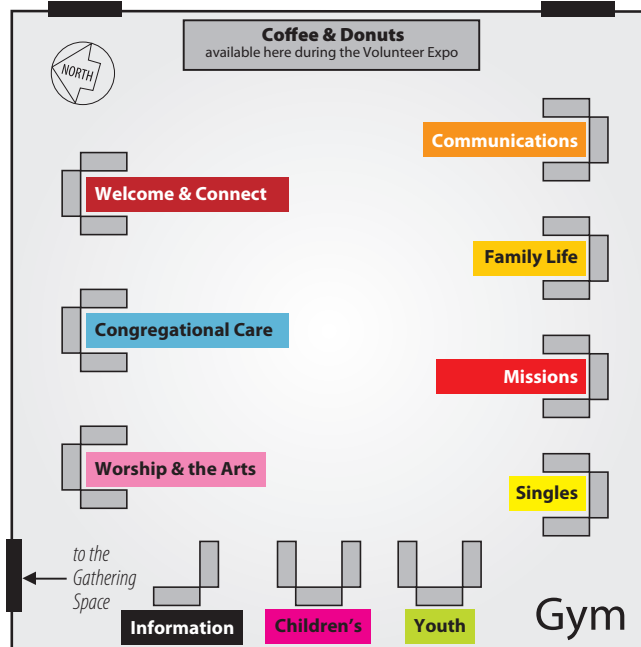


## Volunteer Expo Ministries

### At The Volunteer Expo

Use these suggestions to maximize your time today.

1. Do you have general questions before you get started? Visit the Information Booth. In addition to answering your questions, the Information Booth will have more Volunteer Expo brochures, the new *Guidebook*, and copies of a Spiritual Gifts Inventory (also available at [zpc.org](http://zpc.org)). This is also the place to share new ministry ideas you might have. Are you passionate about something you don't see listed as a ZPC ministry? Let the hosts at the Information Booth know. They'll make sure you are given the chance to share your passion with others.
2. Based on your personal reflection and using the event map above, locate the booth(s) to visit.
3. At any of the booths grab a carabineer and use it to store the ministry cards you collect.
4. Engage in conversation with the booth hosts; they are here for you!
5. **Sign up for at least one "First Serve" or more if you'd like (We would love that!).**

### After The Volunteer Expo

If you sign up for a "First Serve", you will receive a call from the appropriate ministry team leader **within two weeks** to get better acquainted and discuss the details of your "First Serve."

If you do not sign up for a "First Serve" our hope is that you continue to prayerfully consider where God is calling you to serve. Use the ministry cards you collected at the Volunteer Expo as a reference. Contact the staff liaison or ministry team leader to begin a conversation about serving in a capacity that really excites you. We look forward to hearing from you!

*Great expectations...*



During this time, as the disciples were increasing in numbers by leaps and bounds, hard feelings developed among the Greek-speaking believers – "Hellenists" – toward the Hebrew-speaking believers because their widows were being discriminated against in the daily food lines. So the Twelve called a meeting of the disciples. They said, **"It wouldn't be right for us to abandon our responsibilities for preaching and teaching the Word of God to help with the care of the poor. So, friends, choose seven men from among you whom everyone trusts, men full of the Holy Spirit and good sense, and we'll assign them this task. Meanwhile, we'll stick to our assigned tasks of prayer and speaking God's Word."** The congregation thought this was a great idea. They went ahead and chose – Stephen, a man full of faith and the Holy Spirit, Philip, Procorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, Nicolas, a convert from Antioch. Then they presented them to the apostles. Praying, the apostles laid on hands and commissioned them for their task. **The Word of God prospered. The number of disciples in Jerusalem increased dramatically. Not least, a great many priests submitted themselves to the faith.**

### Personal Reflection

In the Bible God repeatedly sets expectations for service. Acts 6 instructs us to invite others to serve. The result is the prospering of God's Word and an increase in the number of disciples. How will you answer the invitation to serve? To get started, take a few minutes to reflect on and answer the questions below.
