How are you?

Tell God about your day, your mood and what is on your mind

Adoration

Praise God for who He is and recognize His character qualities

Confession

Ask God to reveal any sinful thoughts, words or actions you need to be forgiven for. Confess them to Him, and acknowledge that you are forgiven because of Jesus' sacrifice on the cross

Read the Word

Ask for God's Spirit to guide you as you read.

1. Observation: what's going on in this passage?
 - > answer the who, what, when, where, why questions

2. Interpretation: what does it mean?
 - > are there any repeating words or phrases that are being emphasized? Why?
 - > what does this passage tell me about God? About me?

3. Application: what should I do?
 - > what does this passage mean to me personally?
 - > what will I specifically change because of what I have read?

Memorize/ meditate: Bible verse _____

Choose a verse that was significant in your reading, commit to reflecting on it often

Thanksgiving

Say thanks for what He has taught you and all He has done for you

Supplication

Pray for needs you see around you and for needs you have personally as you start or finish your day
