Some of you may have noticed that we had shingles flapping in the strong winds this past winter and spring. We recognized that we needed to do something. On May 14, we began the next phase of our re-roofing project, focusing on the two-story Christian education wing. This project will cost \$53,338. We have the money available in our "rainy day fund." However, as we face summer and the typical "low giving months," it is a stretch to use some of our reserve funds for this project. Please be in prayer that God will continue to guide us and bless us as we seek his wisdom and direction for ZPC in the weeks and months ahead. Finance Team Chairman Bob Bierwagen will be making a summary presentation on the budget in June with more details about the budget and year-end results.
